Statement

A wild horse lives freely, grazing naturally in a gentle continuum of movement, following seasonal plants to help it maintain optimal health according to its needs. The modern day horse, on the other hand, may spend much of its day in a stable, devoid of mental stimulation, isolated from others of its kind, removed from the interaction of his species, eating highly processed foods. This can only have a detrimental effect on both its mental and physical well being.

By using appropriate herbal supplements we can greatly enhance the health of our horses. Herbs reconnect them to their roots, giving them the power to maintain health as their wild cousins do.

Many of the common problems that beset the modern equine develop as a direct result of lack of grazing, exercise, mental stimulus and the companionship of other horses. Horses are herd creatures and need the company of their own kind if they are to flourish both physically and mentally, 'as nature intended.'

Turnout not only provides horses with appropriate fodder to keep their digestive systems functioning correctly, but also offers the stimulus to keep minds occupied, whilst encouraging gentle exercise and movement to ensure muscles and joints are kept healthy and supple.

Fair Trade, Ethical values and Sustainability of raw materials

We are extremely conscious of our responsibility to ensure that the materials we use in the manufacture of our products should not have an adverse impact on the environment, the lives of people harvesting our herbs, or the sustainability of the herbs themselves.

To this end we use only bio-degradeable packing material, our plastic tubs are recyclable, and we do not use herbs that are endangered or appear on the CITES list. We support Fair Trade organizations, helping them to achieve their goals, and only source our herbs from sustainable sources. We do not use animal by-products, fillers or additives in any of our products. The majority of our herbs are cultivated crops, organically grown without the use of pesticides or herbicides, dried naturally and produced by families who have been growing medicinal plants for generations.

Plant Sources - The 'Wild Crafted' versus 'Cultivated' debate!

Although the majority of the herbs we use in our products are cultivated, a small proportion of them are what is called 'wild crafted':

In the past, the term wild crafted has caused confusion, and raised understandable concerns amongst herbalists and the environmentally conscious general public. Understandably it was assumed that wild harvesting of herbs would automatically lead to the destruction of habitats, the loss of indigenous species around the world, and ultimately have a negative impact on the livelihoods of the local people, who may rely on the plant as a source of income, local medicine or both.

Things however are not so gloomy! I was recently furnished with a much more positive example of how wild crafting can be both sustainable, and work to provide a much needed income for the local community. I would like to pass this information onto a wider public, and explain why we should examine the broader implications, before we condemn this practice out of hand.

Devils Claw provides one such example, it is neither endangered nor threatened and there is more than sufficient organic uncultivated supply to satisfy the world's annual requirements many times over. The harvesting of Devils Claw currently supplies the indigenous people of Namibia, Botswana and South Africa with a vital income for 6 months of every year.

Namibia is the biggest supplier of this plant, where it grows in the arid environment of the Kalahari desert. It is the side tubers (which contain the active harpagocide) which come off the main tap root that are harvested, and these can be buried as much as 4 feet below the desert surface.

It can take an individual up to 4 hours to dig up just 1 kilo of these tubers! There are no other industries in the region, and due to its arid climate the area is not capable of generating income from either farming or tourism.

It is estimated that in an average year 12,000 households depend on the income they earn from harvesting Devils Claw. In particular this work benefits women and children who are in the front line of harvesting this plant. Studies have shown that money earned by these women has a much greater impact on the local economy, because women are far more likely to spend their income on the family! Conversely, cash handouts from charities tend to be distributed to the male head of the household, who may not always spend it so wisely!

If one were to make a comparison between the number of households that currently benefit from the wild harvesting of Devils Claw, and the employment that would be generated by cultivating this plant, there is no contest.

It is estimated that between 20 - 30 farmers (probably located in South Africa), employing a total of 300 labourers, could cultivate the world's annual requirement for Devils Claw. The 300 labourers who would work for these farmers would not be drawn from the people who currently wild craft the herb. Therefore 12,000 households would lose a vital income if this plant were to be cultivated rather than sourced from the wild.

I hope this explanation has demonstrated how it is wrong to assume that just because a plant is 'wild crafted', it will automatically have a negative impact on the habitat or the local community.

Prohibited Substances

In recent years there have been moves by the various Equestrian regulatory bodies (USEF, USDF, FEI, Jockey Club etc) to identify certain herbs as being prohibited for use in competition (e.g. Valerian). The lists are constantly updated and other herbs may yet be designated as prohibited. During our manufacturing process, we take every care to ensure that the herbs in our products are free from common contaminants (Caffeine, Theobromine etc). However by their very nature, some herbs will contain naturally occurring substances such as Camphor or Menthol that are prohibited in competition. We are therefore unable to guarantee any of our products as being absolutely safe to use in competition. We would advise all competitors to contact their appropriate governing body in order to ascertain exactly which substances are prohibited for use in their particular discipline.

Quality Assurance

In the US the majority of our pure herbal products are regarded as Non Food. This is because many of the herbs included in our mixes do not appear in the AAFCO (Association of American Feed Control Officials) list of approved feed ingredients. We would assure our customers that this is not because the herbs are in any way unsuitable for ingestion, more that they have never been submitted to AAFCO for assessment as an animal feed ingredient. As Non Food our products therefore fall under the jurisdiction of the FDA, and must comply with FDA labelling requirements.

NASC – National Animal Supplements Council

Hilton Herbs is a member of the NASC, an industry group dedicated to protecting and enhancing the health of companion animals and horses throughout the USA. The NASC membership is made up of animal supplements manufacturers, committed to the highest standards of quality in the industry. www.nasc.cc. Hilton Herbs holds the NASC's – 'Seal of Quality'. In 2006 the company was successfully audited and awarded a compliance rating of 'A' by the association for its manufacturing and Quality Control procedures. We believe we are the only UK company to hold the NASC's Seal of Quality. In Europe our products are designated as 'Complementary Feedingstuffs'.

European law requires that manufacturers of complementary feedingstuffs must operate a QA scheme, with strict manufacturing controls in place to ensure full traceability of ingredients from field to feed. To ensure these standards are achieved the manufacturer must be externally audited each year by the European Feed Safety Inspection Service (EFSIS). Hilton Herbs is fully accredited by both EFSIS and UFAS (Universal Feed Assurance Scheme). www.efsis.com.

Harnessing veterinary science's greater knowledge of equine health conditions, and combining it with the latest herbal research, she has created new innovative and unique products. She also took the opportunity to 'fine tune' both our dry and liquid herbal blends to make them even more effective. Dry Herbal Formulations

Directions for use - Administer orally.

A measuring scoop is included in each tub or refill bag of our dry herbal formulations. Full directions for use and storage are given on the back of each tub/bag as follows:

Up to 12.2 hh (128cm)

1 Scoop Daily

12.2 hh – 14.2 hh (128cm – 148cm)

2 Scoops Daily

14.2 hh - 15.2 hh (148cm – 158cm)

3 Scoops Daily

15.2 hh – 16.2 hh (158cm – 169cm)

4 Scoops Daily

16.2 hh and above (169cm and above)

4 – 5 Scoops Daily

A 2.2lb tub will last approximately one month when administered at 3 level scoops daily (this may vary depending on mix). Introduce the herbs gradually over a period of several days. If possible divide the daily quantity into two. Please allow approximately 2 - 3 weeks for complete absorption. Replace lid firmly after use. Store in a cool dry place, away from direct sunlight.

All our Gold Solutions are now identical to their dry mix counterparts. Some horse owners may prefer our Gold Solutions because they are more readily assimilated by the horses digestive system, producing a quicker response, if necessary they may be orally syringed. Many of our customers like to start their horses on our liquid formulations and then switch onto the dried mix equivalent for longer term use. Our Gold Solutions are packed in easy to use, sturdy plastic bottles with integrated measuring tank marked from 10 – 25mls. For details of our tincture preparation see page 43.

Directions for Use: Administer orally

Up to 12.2 hh (128cm)

5mls twice daily

12.2 hh – 14.2 hh (128cm – 148cm)

10mls twice daily

14.2 hh – 15.2 hh (148cm – 158cm)

12.5mls twice daily

15.2 hh – 16.2 hh (158cm – 169cm)

15mls twice daily

16.2 hh and above (169cm and above)

15mls – 20mls twice daily

Shake well before use.

When administered at 30 mls daily 2.1pts (1 liter) will last 33 days. Introduce gradually over a period of several days. If possible divide the daily quantity into two doses. Can be orally syringed directly into the mouth if necessary. Please allow 7 days for complete absorption.

Store in cool place, away from direct sunlight.

Himalayan Rock Salt Licks

The Salt Lick on a Rope!

The distinctive rose pink colour comes from the salts' high mineral content, such as iron, potassium and magnesium, which are all vital for maintaining health. Mass produced salt licks are produced using salt with minerals added in the manufacturing process.

Himalayan rock salt licks are literally 'rock hard', this means that horses and ponies are unable to bite chunks off the block, a problem that can occur with the softer 'pressed' salt licks.

These licks are also much more weather resistant and will not dissolve into a mush when left out in the rain, which means they can be safely left outside in the field for horse to 'self dose'. Our experience has show that horses do prefer these to other salt licks.

We also sell Himalayan Rock salt in granular form for use in Salt Mills, for all you budding 'domestic goddesses' out there!

We care just as much about the quality of the tinctures we use in our proprietary mixes, as the herbs we sell. In fact the majority of our tinctures are produced for us using our very own herbs. All our tinctures are made using the following traditional method. First the plant material (herb, flower, leaf, root etc) is macerated (steeped) in a combination of ethyl-alcohol (made from fermented sugar beet) and water over a period of three weeks. The ratio of water to alcohol will vary, depending on whether the plant's constituents/active ingredients are water soluble or alcohol soluble. At the end of the maceration period the plant material is pressed (just like in an apple press) and the liquid containing all the vital active constituents is poured off.

We stock over 60 tinctures, obviously this includes all the tinctures in our proprietary mixes, but we also have many others that Hilary uses for her special mixes or in her dispensary. Unfortunately we don't have the room to list them all, but here are a few of the most commonly requested. The majority of our tinctures are 1:3 (that is one part of plant material to 3 parts of liquid) the % denotes the percentage of alcohol to water in the liquid part of the tincture.

Homeopathy for Horses

In recent years the use of homeopathics for horses has dramatically increased. Owners and trainers who have successfully used homeopathic products for themselves, are gaining confidence in their application for horses, dogs and other animals.

At Hilton Herbs we stock over 230 homeopathic's in a variety of potencies (6c, 30c, 200c, 1M, plus several combinations).

The majority of these are in the hard tablet form, with a few liquid products. All our homeopathic tablets are supplied in dark glass vials (7g approx 50 tablets). Our liquid homeopathics are supplied in 30ml dark glass dropper bottles.

Any information given by our Helpline is taken from a variety of excellent books on the use of homeopathy for horses and other animals. Including **Homeopathy for Horses by Tim Couzens BvetMed, MRCVS, VetMFHom, CertVet AC**. An invaluable reference for all horse owners, equine therapists and veterinarians. (See our books section).

We hope that customers who are not so familiar with the use of homeopathics may find the following basic instructions useful.

How to administer and store homeopathic tablets or liquids, as recommended in

Homeopathy for Horses – Tim Couzens.

- The quantity given (one tablet) is the same regardless of size, weight, height or age of animal. It makes no difference if it is an elephant or a mouse!
- Do not handle the tablet. The surface of the tablet is potentised, oil or sweat from your skin will reduce the potency.
- Tip one tablet into the cap of the container and then directly into the lower lip of the horse. Owners may find it easier to use a small piece of apple/carrot, make a small hole in it, tip the tablet into the hole and then give it to the horse.
- Liquids (about 10 drops) can either be dropped straight into the horse's lower lip or dropped onto the cut surface of an apple and then fed.
- Never return unused tablets or tablets that have been dropped back into the container.
- Always keep the lid on the glass vial and store containers out of strong sunlight, at room temperature and away from extremes of temperature.
- Keep away from strong smells, perfumes and essential oils such as camphor, eucalyptus etc.
- Keep away from sources of electromagnetic radiation such as cell phones, televisions, computers and microwaves.
